Position overview

The Assets & Operations Group is focussed on ensuring the organisation remains adaptive and ahead of the climate and population changes by harnessing innovation, effective management of water resources together with the strategic planning and building of infrastructure. The Assets & Operations Group proactively generate business opportunities for the corporation by developing new insights through external collaborations and facilitate an innovative corporate culture to energise the corporation's innovation effort.

Coliban Water is currently delivering the Big Water Build - a once in a generation opportunity to deliver upwards of \$435 million in a capital works program over the next five to ten years. Reporting to a Senior Project Manager within the Bendigo and Castlemaine Water Reclamation Plants (WRP) Upgrade Program, the Technical Specialist Operations will assist with the safe, efficient and compliant delivery of project work. As part of the Big Water Build, a range of technical and complex renewal and upgrade projects will be delivered at both the Bendigo and Castlemaine WRPs.

On top of this capital works program, Coliban Water are assisting their contracted partners in delivering, on the ground plant operational activities. The Technical Specialist Operations will also be applying an in-depth knowledge and understanding of water treatment plant and equipment, in a day to day plant operations environment.

As mentioned above, Coliban Water are focussed on a culture of Act. By Act we mean, we are brave in our decision making and take action. The Technical Specialist Engineer will help Coliban Water understand their treatment technologies and will assist in building confidence for capital expenditure and operational activity decisions.

- Providing a technical overview of each individual project's design, documentation and implementation plan
- Act as the operational liaison between existing plant operations and works required under the capital uplift projects underway at each plant.
- Facilitate a high level of integration between the upgrade works and existing plant operations.
- Lead the development of new or updated procedures and policies as they relate to the upgrade projects and impact to existing operational practices
- Undertake testing and commissioning activities relevant to plant and/or process upgrade projects
